What will the first day of school be like?

On the first day of school, September 3rd, when you arrive at KLO you will find lists of homerooms posted in front of the school. You will find your name on one of the lists, look for the room number, then make your way to that classroom. There will be lots of adults and WEB leaders to help you find your way.

After attendance is taken in your homeroom classroom you will head to the gym for an

assembly. Following the assembly your homeroom teacher will give you more information about KLO including your timetable.

You will go to homeroom first thing every day for the first week to help you stay organized and give you an opportunity to ask questions.

We have a team of helpful people, including our WEB leaders, who will make the transition to KLO as smooth as possible for you.

WEB orientation for all grade 7 students is August 29th from 9am to 12:00pm in the gym. You will get a call from a WEB leader a couple of days before August 29th.

What should I bring on the first day of school?

The only thing you will need on the first day will be a pencil/pen. Your teachers will tell you about any supplies you will need for their classes. The first official day of school, September 3rd, is a half day. Dismissal will be at 11:52am.



Important Dates

WEB leaders will call grade 7s a couple of days before August 29th to invite you to WEB orientation.

WEB orientation is August 29th from 9:00am to 12:00pm

The first day of regular school is September 3rd. This is a half day from 9:00am to 11:52am.

School buses will be running on September 3rd.

What is a WEB Leader?

Every grade 7 student will be paired with a grade 9 WEB leader who will be with you for the whole grade 7 year.

This leader will be trained to help you have fun and be successful in middle school.

What is the block rotation?

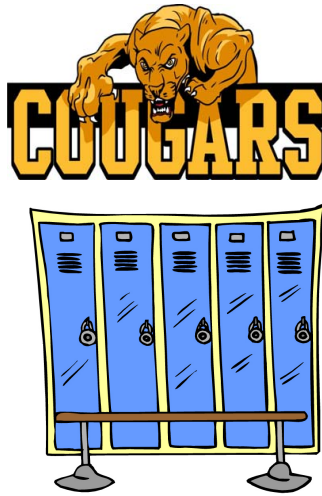

Will I have homework?

You will have homework most nights because homework is not just work assigned by your teacher to complete at home. Homework is also the practice of learning, reviewing, organizing and reading.

Will there be a break during the day?

There are breaks in the morning and afternoon. These are times to use the washroom, eat snacks, go to lockers and get to your next class.

What is the lunch routine?

You can bring a lunch from home. We also have a School Meals Program in our cafeteria where you can sign up to purchase your lunch four days a week. As well, we have a school store which sells a variety of items for lunch everyday. KLO also has vending machines which have a selection of healthy snacks and drinks. If you forget your lunch be sure to let an adult know. We don't want you to go hungry! We will find you something to eat.

Can you leave school during lunch?

No. Like all middle schools in SD23, KLO is a "closed campus" school. You can't leave for lunch unless you have permission from your parents saying that you can go home for lunch. If you live close enough to walk home for lunch without an adult, we need a note on file in the office saying you have your parent/guardian's permission to do so. You cannot take friends home with you.

Does everyone get a locker?

Yes, everyone gets use of their own locker. Make sure you record your combination privately and tell no one! The school locker is the property of the school and if necessary can be searched by school administration if there is reason to do so. School lockers must be kept clean and free of old food items. Personal locks are not permitted. There is no sharing or trading of locks or lockers.

When will I get my locker?

You won't get your locker on the first day of school. We will give them out to you during your homeroom block during the first week of school.

What if I forget my locker combination?

Don't panic! (Even some of the grade 9's forget their combination.) You can get your combination from the office at any time. Just ask.
